Terms and conditions

- For validation, customers must present a paper voucher.
- Not to be used in conjunction with any other offer such as Corporate Fitness.

What is the Active Kids Rebate program?

From January 2018, the NSW Government will provide a rebate through a voucher system to parents and guardians of school-enrolled children.

The \$100 voucher is to be used for registration and participation costs for sport and fitness activities.

The initiative will reduce the barriers of participation and help change the physical activity behaviours of children and young people in NSW.

The majority of children and adolescents in NSW are not meeting the daily recommended levels of physical activity. In 2015, more than one in five children in NSW were overweight or obese.

Who is eligible to claim the voucher?

Every family in NSW with a child enrolled in school from kindergarten to Year 12 will be eligible for the Active Kids Rebate.

It will not be means tested and one voucher will be available for every child in the family annually over the next four years.

There will be no limits on the number of applications per family, as long as every child is enrolled in school.

What can the voucher be used for?

You can use your voucher for registration or membership fees for after-school, weekend sport and structured physical activity programs, including Learn to Swim and Squad programs.
