How to re-enrol

The easiest way to re-enrol is through our [My Swim](#) Portal.

What to do

1. [Create an online account](#) via myswim.lakemac.com.au or [log in](#) to your existing My Swim account.

Note: If you're new to our My Swim portal, please contact reception to link your child's profile to your account.

2. [Re-enrol into your current lesson](#) day and time, **OR** [select a new day and time of the same class level](#).

Can I use an Active Kids or First Lap Voucher?

Please [call](#) or visit reception. Note that vouchers are valued at \$50, and the remaining balance must be paid to complete your enrolment, as part-payments are not accepted.

Are there other ways to enrol?

Yes, you can enrol in person or over the phone. **Full-term payment is required up front for all Learn to Swim enrolments.** If you are unable to afford the full-term payment upfront, [financial assistance payment plans](#) are available to approved applicants

Children: Those aged 5 and older with prior lesson experience must complete a [swimming assessment](#). For others, including infants over 6 months, please contact the Swim Centre for an over-the-phone or email assessment to be placed directly into a class or complete our [online swim level assessment](#) to enrol online.

Adults: No assessment required. Enrol directly into an [Adult Learn to Swim class](#) online.
